	CORNEY & BARROW BLANC DE BLANCS (Sparkling wine) Made by Varichon et Clerc and bottle-fermented in the traditional fashion this is a rather stylish, crisp wine with delicate biscuit notes. 	LAURENT PERRIER, BRUT, NV Pale gold in colour with fine and persistent bubbles. Delicate and fresh aromas with good complexity and notes of citrus and with fruit. Fresh and supple upon entry with rounded and expressive flavours from which the fruit progressively emerges. Good balance and length.	£55.00	
	PERRIER JOUET NV, GRAND BRUT A fresh fizz with light appley fruit and citrus notes that linger on the elegant finish. Superbly balanced	£70.00	
	LAURENT PERRIER, 1990, BRUT Only produced in exceptional years from the best grand cru sites and with roughly equal parts of chardonnay and pinot noir. Now fully mature, this champagne displays peachy ripe aromas with hints of grapefruit, chocolate and crème brulee, while the palate has richly endowed concentrated mature fruit, a whiff of vanilla and still a lovely freshness.	£90.00

- 16 VINO GANADERO, 2003, RUEDO, SPAIN** £19.50
Made from the sought-after Verdejo grape, blended with small amounts of Viura, this wine is full with fresh stone fruit character, completed by an aromatic and interesting minerality.
- 17 ESTATE RIESLING, 2008, SCHLOSS, SCHONBORN, RHEINGAU, GERMANY** £23.95
Riesling is making a very welcome comeback and it is not hard to see why. Effortlessly floral with wonderfully delicate orchard fruits and a refreshing crisp acidity, elegance itself!
- 18 PYRAMID HILL SEMILLON, 2007, HUNTER VALLEY, AUSTRALIA** £27.50
A truly delicious great value wine, aromas of stone fruits, citrus and delicate spice are followed by a nutty minerality and a creamy texture
- 19 LOFTHOUSE ESTATE SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2008, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND** £27.95
The Lofthouse Estate is situated in the heart of the favoured Rapaura district of Marlborough, next to the original Cloudy Bay Vineyard. Fresh and crisp, with a nettley floral aroma and a succulent racy palate, crammed with rich gooseberry fruit - delicious.

LIGHT, FRESH AND DRY

- 20 OLD VINES CHENIN BLANC, 2008, STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA** £22.50
Fantastic example from "the Queen of Steen (Chenin Blanc)" according to South African wine guru, John Platter. Honeyed tropical fruit, lime zest and a natural definition and minerality
- 21 VINAMAR RESERVE SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2008, VALLEY CENTRAL, CHILE** £22.50
Delightfully elegant and fresh, with vivacious, clean, crisp aromas followed by fleshy, ripe green fruits with a sharp finish
- 22 SOAVE CLASSICO DOC "BROGNOLIGO" 2008, CECILIA BERETTA, ITALY** £23.50
Ripe, warm, semi tropical fruit, bone dry and truly satisfying. Deliciously elegant and fine
- 23 SANCERRE "DOMAINE DE LA GRANDE MAISON" 2008, CHAUMEAU BALLAND, FRANCE** £35.00
Refreshingly intense gooseberry fruit with fine acidity and a steely elegance. Superb example from this great producer
- 24 POUILLY FUME LES CHAUMIENNES, 2008, ANDRE AND EDMOND FIGEAT, LOIRE, FRANCE** £37.50
Superb wine from this single vineyard - bright and lively on the nose with an elegant, delicate minerality on the palate, and a distinctly smokey, flinty overtone

RICH AND FULL

- 25 NELSONS CREEK CHARDONNAY, 2004, PAARL, SOUTH AFRICA** £23.95
Tropical style, rich and leesy, layered with vanilla cream. A light oak compliments the fruit wonderfully
- MACON VERZE, 2005, DOMAINE LEFLAIVE** £33.50
Light straw in the glass, a clean and fresh nose displays lovely stonefruit aromas that lead to a crisp, lively, concentrated and well balanced palate with a lot of lemony freshness at the finish
- 26 MONTAGNY 1ER CRU, "BONNEVAUX" 2005, OLIVIER LEFLAIVE** £35.00
The name of Olivier Leflaive is synonymous with the very best of white Burgundy and this wine shows why. Delicate, buttery overtones on the palate and a good weight of fruit and subtle oak character. Great wine, great year and without a doubt great value!
- BOURGOGNE BLANC CUVÉE OLIGOCENE, 2004, DOMAINE PATRICK JAVILLIER** £36.00
With an immediately attractive nose of toast and butter reminiscent of Meursault, this Bourgogne Blanc is wonderfully rounded and has a real sense of weight leading on to a long, harmonious finish
- 27 CHABLIS 1ER CRU "MONTEE DE TONNERRE" 2008, DOMAINE SERVIN** £42.50
The Montee de Tonnerre 1er cru site is one of only two situated next to the 7 Grand Cru sites, due north of the town of Chablis and benefits like them from their full southerly exposure. There is a lovely elegance here allied to a certain richness and refined minerality from this great producer
- MARSANNAY BLANC, 2004, DOMAINE TRAPET** £43.00
The colour already bodes well with its rich red hue. The nose offers savoury aromas of plum, chalk and wheat - with a waft of toasted barrels on the empty glass. The experience continues with medium acidity, tangy and slightly cheek-drying tannins, fresh cherry fruit and a hint of orange
- 28 PULIGNY MONTRACHET 1ER CRU CLAVOILLON, 2003, DOMAINE LEFLAIVE** £85.00
This offers a floral, perfumed nose, fresh fruit and a hint of nougat. This is truly one of the greatest white wines from arguably the best Puligny producer and a great year. This is a bargain at this price from Anne Claude Leflaive, who is considered by many to be the greatest white winemaker in the world

RED WINES**FRUITY AND MEDIUM BODIED**

- 29 BAINSKLOOF MERLOT, 2007, BREEDE RIVER, SOUTH AFRICA** £21.50
Richly coloured with a very appealing brightly spiced nose, while fresh ripe cherry and cassis fruits on the palate, going to a long herbal finish
- 30 VINAMAR RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2007, VALLEY CENTRAL, CHILE** £21.50
Classic in style - Smooth, full bodied and deeply fruited with cassis and spice, allied to a gentle oaking from French Oak
- 31 VALPOLICELLA SUPERIORE DOC "ROCCOLO DI MIZZOLE" 2006, CECILIA BERETTA, ITALY** £23.95
Deep ruby red, with fine bitter cherry fruit, soft and ripe with a nice bite of acidity on the end - delicious
- 32 RHEBOKSKLOOF PINOTAGE, 2007, PAARL, SOUTH AFRICA** £25.00
A ripe, full bodied Pinotage with a complex, smoky palate and savoury, toasted notes underpinning a rich fruit character
- 33 COTES DU RHONE RESERVE, 2007, DOMAINE PERRIN, PHONE, FRANCE** £25.00
Fabulous Cotes du Rhone from this highly specialist producer in Chateauneuf du Pape. Rich, complex and long
- 34 BOURGOGNE PINOT NOIR, DOMAINE CYROT-BUTHIAU, COTE D'OR FRANCE, 2007** £26.95
Ripe red fruit aroma with subtle tones of strawberry and cassis. This wine has a soft tannic back bone with herb and leather notes on the long finish
- 35 THE GATEKEEPER SHIRAZ, 2005, McLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA** £27.95
Picking at night has preserved freshness, producing a bright, elevated spiced quality complimenting black cherry fruit
- 36 CHATEAU LA COUROLLE, 2006, MONTAGNE, ST. EMILLION, BORDEAUX, FRANCE** £29.50
This lovely property has produced a wonderfully supple, sappy cherry-rich blend which coats the palate. Very keenly balanced, it has a sensual silky texture
- 37 DOMAINE TRIGANT DE BOISSET, 2004, POMEROL, FRANCE** £45.00
Drinking beautifully now this elegant style of Pomerol is supple, yet nicely concentrated with dark fruits and Asiatic spices
- BIG AND FULL BODIED**
- 38 MALBEC RESERVE, 2006, BODEGA RUCA MALEN, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA** £29.50
10 months in oak adds weight and complexity to this black fruited, richly concentrated Malbec – beautifully weighted, intense and very fine. Great with steak, whether on the pampas or not!
- 39 EAGLE VALE MERLOT, 2004, MARGARET RIVER, AUSTRALIA** £35.00
Bright, ruby in colour, this presents sweet, slightly earthy cassis fruit, floral notes and bright, aromatic spiced red berries
- 40 CHATEAU CARIGNAN, 2002, 1ERES COTES DE BORDEAUX, FRANCE** £35.00
Pungent red and black fruits on the nose, ripe and fat. The palate is silky on entry, very rich with concentrated fruit, firm ripe tannins, sweetly dense to the finish. An extremely serious wine. The best loved of this appellation
- 41 CHATEAU DE LAMARQUE, 2001, CRU BORGEAIS, HAUT MEDOC, BORDEAUX, FRANCE** £37.50
Spectacular pureed blackcurrants, tobacco leaf and spices leap from the glass, followed by a richly powerful, yet elegantly restrained palate of complex black fruits. A cracking vintage for top end Claret - drinking now
- 42 AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA, PASQUA, D.O 2005, ITALY** £49.50
Made from raisined grapes, this is a serious affair, with its profound brooding, smokey palate, intensely fruited, layered and spiced
- 43 NUITS ST GEORGE 1ER CRU CLOS DE L'ARLOT, 2003, DOMAINE L'ARLOT, BURGUNDY, FRANCE** £59.50
This is without doubt one of the finest producers in this, one of the greatest villages in Burgundy. This powerful wine, from a walled vineyard beside the house is beautifully balanced, showing concentrated, rich brambly fruit of some muscle and texture, combined with a delightful elegance and a gently spiced oak
